<p>Know the data your model is trained on.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Investigate the data.○ Training data vs. system's input data.○ Potential bias in the datasets.○ Understand data rights issues – IPR, Copyright etc.	<p>Define the limitations of your system.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Mark the out-of-bounds – unintended use of the code/product.○ Narrow definition of your system – explore its limits, evil ramifications.○ System replaces humans – reviewing the certifications, licenses that apply.	<p>Brainstorm how your system might fail - and what harm might result.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Take time to assess and mitigate potential failure modes.○ Can your system be tricked or gamed?○ When used inside your sandbox, what's the worst that can happen?

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
